ORDINANCE #98

An Ordinance of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, prohibiting the keeping within the Borough of swine, poultry, horses, cows, sheep and goats, excepting under certain conditions.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Borough of Patterson Heights that from and after the effective date of this Ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm, firms, corporation or corporations, either as principal or agent, to keep within the Borough of Patterson Heights any swine, poultry, horses, cows, sheep or goats: Provided that riding horses may be kept in the Borough if the stable in which they are kept is maintained in a proper and sanitary manner and is not nearer than one hundred (100) feet to any dwelling; that cows may be kept within the Borough only if the barn in which they are kept is maintained in a sanitary manner and not nearer than one hundred (100) feet to any dwelling; that chickens may be kept in the Borough only if they are confined in coops or pens not nearer than one hundred (100) feet to any dwelling.

A violation of this Ordinance shall subject the offender upon conviction before the Burgess or any Justice of the Peace of the County of Beaver to a fine of not less than One (1.00) Dollar nor more than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, and in case of nonpayment of such fine to imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not exceeding ten days for such offense. In case of a second violation by the same offender the fine shall be not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars nor more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and in case of non-payment of such fine to imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.

If any provision of this Ordinance shall be found to be unconstitutional or otherwise defective, it shall not effect the validity of the other provisions of said Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall become effective and shall be enforced on and after the first day of February, 1942.
