

Ordinance No. 99

An Ordinance of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, fixing the tax levy for all Borough purposes for the year 1942.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, that the tax levy for all purposes for the year 1942, is hereby levied on all property, offices, professions, and persons made taxable by the laws of this Commonwealth, for county rates and levies, as follows:

Section 1. For general Borough purposes, twelve (12) mil on the dollar, equivalent to one and two-tenths (1.2) Dollars on the hundred dollars of assessed valuation; and for sink fund and retirement of bonds, two (2) mills on the dollar or twenty one-hundredths (.20) Dollars on the hundred dollars of assessed valuation.

Section 2. Said taxes may, at the option of the taxpayer, be paid in five (5) equal installments as follows: June 30, 1942, August 31, 1942, October 31, 1942, December 31, 1942, and February 28, 1943. To each installment, on the date it becomes delinquent, a penalty of five (5) per cent shall be added.

Section 3. The payment of the first installment by a taxpayer, before the same becomes delinquent, shall be conclusive evidence of an intention to pay on the installment plan, as provided by this Ordinance, and if a taxpayer shall thereafter permit one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) or more of the total number of installments of taxes to become delinquent, an additional penalty of three (3) per cent shall be added to each such delinquent installment.

Section 4. Where a taxpayer shall fail to evidence an intention to pay on the installment plan as hereinbefore provided, his, her or its taxes shall become due and payable and be collected under existing laws, subject to the discounts, penalties and interest provided by such laws.
