

Ordinance No. 136

An Ordinance of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, prohibiting drivers of vehicles from parking their vehicles on the west side of Sixth Avenue in said Borough where "No Parking" signs are erected, and providing penalties for the violation thereof.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Patterson Heights, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1. "No Parking" signs uniform in appearance with No Parking signs as required by the Vehicle Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania be erected along the west side of Sixth Avenue in said Borough, southwardly from Seventh Street, the said signs to be so located as to be plainly visible to all traffic traversing the said Sixth Avenue.

Section 2. That no driver of any vehicle of any kind whatsoever shall park his vehicle on the west side of Sixth Avenue, southwardly from Seventh Street, in said Borough, where "No Parking" signs are erected, at any time.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation being convicted of the violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance before any Justice of the Peace shall be subject to a fine of Five (\$5.00) Dollars for each separate offense, and in default thereof to imprisonment for a period of not more than five (5) days.
