

**BOROUGH OF PATTERSON HEIGHTS  
COUNCIL MINUTES  
JANUARY 21, 2025**

The regular meeting was called to order by Council President Bill Starn at 7:00 p.m. and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. It was announced that the meeting was being recorded, and the roll was called.

**Attendance** -- Council Members attending included Bryan Landman, David Lee, and Wade Robinson. Other officials in attendance were , Solicitor Nate Morgan, Police Chief Nick Bathgate, Fire Chief Jason Medlin, Tax Collector Nadine Galbreath, Vacancy Chair Jocelyn Phillips, and Secretary/Treasurer Jack Doyle.

**Agenda** – Bryan Landman moved that the Agenda be approved, David Lee seconded, and the Council approved the Agenda.

**Minutes** – Bryan Landman moved that the minutes from December 17, 2025 be approved. Wade Robinson seconded, and Council approved. Bryan Landman moved that the minutes from the January 5, 2026, meeting be approved. David Lee seconded, and Council approved.

**Visitors** – No visitors sought recognition.

**Police Report** – The December Police Report was presented by Chief Bathgate, and showed 45 calls for service with one citation and one warning.

**Fire Report** – The Fire Company responded to 55 calls in December, consisting of 43 EMS and 12 fire. A Night at the Races event will be held on February 14 at the Patterson Township hall. Bill Starn announced that he told the Township that we would join them in applying for a grant to bring the moving Viet Nam Wall Memorial to the area. Jason said that the VFD had purchased a used truck nine years newer than the one it will replace. Last year the department handled 445 calls, consisting of 111 fire and 334 ems calls. The department put in 4,248 hours in 2025. Trainings are ongoing.

**Tax Collector** – Nadine reported that \$3,671.27 was deposited in December, leaving \$6,136 to be collected. Borough tax notices will be mailed out on March 1, 2026.

**Correspondence** – (1) a warning that Brady’s Run Dam is “High-Hazard;” (2) individual financial disclosure forms were distributed.

**Code Enforcement** – Council will try to establish who the executor of the estate is, also information on 702 4<sup>th</sup> Street.

**Treasurer’s Report** – The Treasurer provided a report of receipts in the month since the last council meeting.
