Brother-in-Law James Cox, his wife Jamie and daughter Brianna. Brother-in-Law Joe Cox, his wife Lauren and their

daughters Lindsey and Josie. Jimmy was proud to attend his niece's graduations the week prior, enjoying spending quality family time together. Jimmy's journey wasn't just about familial bonds; he was also a proud graduate of Devry University, where he learned the ways of the force in electronics, only to channel his powers into becoming the owner/operator of Exterminating Specialist Inc.
