She enjoyed making quilts for her dear family and friends and took pride in contributing her skills for quilts honoring Native American Code Talkers and Quilts of Valor.

Marian is survived by her children: Jeffrey Blair (Michelle); Andrew Wood; David Scheid (Cynthia); Julie Meyers; Diane McKinney; Kay Shaver (Mike); her sister Lois Irene Reitz of Kansas City, Missouri; her nieces Joann Adams and Susan Doyle (Jim); and brother-in-law John M. Reitz. She leaves 9 grandchildren, 6 great-grandchildren, and many other family members and friends. Her warmhearted, generous, fun, and friendly spirit will be greatly missed.
