



# Culture & Christmas in Krakow

Monday 30 November -  
Thursday 03 December 2026

## MONDAY 30 NOVEMBER 2026

Various return flight options to Krakow are available from London Gatwick, London Stansted and Luton Airport to operate this tour. We will meet our **local guide**, who will accompany us for the duration of the tour, for the transfer to our central hotel. We will have an **orientation tour**, followed by **dinner**.

## TUESDAY 01 DECEMBER 2026

This morning we will visit **Wawel Cathedral**. Erected in 1320-64, it is a Gothic structure with a series of chapels built around it; the most notable of which is Sigismund Chapel, designed by the Florentine architect, Bartolomeo Berrecci.

We will also visit **Wawel Castle** that dates mainly from the Renaissance, although there was a sequence of fortifications and buildings long before. Among the treasures of the Castle's State Art Collection is the largest single collection of 16<sup>th</sup> century Arras tapestries made for King Sigismund the Old and King Sigismund Augustus, which depict biblical scenes.

The afternoon and evening will be at leisure. The **Krakow Christmas Market** is located on the main square and contains around 80 timber huts selling all manner of gifts such as jewellery, trinkets, hand-painted glass decorations and carved wooden toys. A variety of food and drink is also on offer, including traditional Polish cuisine, an assortment of Eastern European pastries, mulled wine and heated beer.

## WEDNESDAY 02 DECEMBER 2026

This morning we will visit the **Kazimierz District**. Founded in 1335 by King Kazimierz, it is today associated with Jews and has a small Jewish quarter. Sights include St Catherine's Church, the Remuh Synagogue and Old Synagogue.

We will also explore Krakow's market square, Rynek Glowny, and visit the **Church of St Mary**, a fine Gothic building with a magnificent late Gothic altarpiece sculpted in linden-wood by Veit Stross (known to Poles as Wit Stwosz).

The afternoon and evening will be at leisure.

## THURSDAY 03 DECEMBER 2026

We will check out of the hotel and travel to the **Royal Salt Mines**, a labyrinth of tunnels spanning over 300 kilometres and distributed over nine levels. The highlight of the tour is the Blessed St Kinga's Chapel, in which everything in the 50 metre long chapel is carved from salt.
