- Attend monthly luncheons
- Volunteer at fundraising events
- Be accountable for maintaining a budget and spending under budget whenever possible.
- Promote the LPWC to visitors, guests and prospective members
- Keep confidential those matters discussed within the confines of the monthly meeting
- Discourage gossip and avoid misunderstanding by listening to complaint and relaying the information to the President in a timely manner.
- Support the Los Prados Women's Club within the Los Prados community.
