Bonanza Cat Hospital / Poppy Foundation

The Poppy Foundation raises funds for the veterinary care, shelter and food for medically unadoptable pets.

Family Promise

Family Promise is a community-based approach to solving homelessness, engaging both the local community, as well as, an interfaith network in the effort to combat family homelessness. Guests in our program receive a full complement of resources, support and training as they work towards their own stability and self-reliance.

Shelter of Hope Las Vegas Rescue Mission

The Las Vegas Rescue Mission strives to be the model for providing hope and change to the homeless, addicted, and others in need. We do this through feeding the hungry, sheltering the homeless, and by offering care, support, and an introduction to a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. In the end, we provide redemption, recovery, and re-entry to independent living.

New Vista Ranch

New Vista Ranch homes offer a 24-hour presence with live-in, dedicated staff to assist intellectually challenged individuals with life skills training, medical appointments, and varied social and recreational activities.

The Mammovan

Nevada Health Centers funds a mobile mammogram clinic and is a private, not for profit 501(c)3 corporation. It is a federally Qualified Health Center, commonly called a Community Health Center program, that is partially funded under Section 330 of the Public Health Service Act. All the physicians are board certified or board eligible and are licensed in the State of Nevada. Patients are not discriminated against in the delivery of healthcare services.

Saint Therese Center – HIV Outreach

The St. Therese Center reaches out to those touched by HIV/AIDS to provide spiritual, physical and emotional support, educational and social services in the spirit of love and compassion.

Saint Therese Center, named after Saint Therese of Lisieux, is a Catholic ministry that welcomes and serves people of all faiths and extends the Lord's healing to all persons infected and affected by HIV/AIDS.

Emphasizing wellness, Saint Therese Center reaches out to those touched by HIV/AIDS to provide spiritual, physical and emotional support, educational and social services in the spirit of love and compassion.

On the Rocks

A nonprofit organization started by a recovering alcoholic to keep the youth sober and busy. He got into rock climbing as an alternative activity and now counsels teens with alcohol and drug problems and takes them rock climbing. He has been sober for ten years. His expenses include gas, equipment, liability insurance, paying certified climbers, etc. He has helped dozens of teens.

Spirit Therapies

A therapeutic riding center that positively impacts the lives of the physically and mentally challenged through connecting with trained therapy horses, certified instructors and compassionate volunteers. Riders with Down's Syndrome, autism, spinal cord injuries and military vets experience the joy of horseback riding.

Embracing Project

The leading nonprofit advocate for sexually exploited youth in Clark County. They provide healing services to children and youth who are victims/survivors of sexual exploitation, sex trafficking and violence. The Embracing Project is an offshoot of The Center for Peace.

Street Teens

Street Teens helps homeless and at-risk teens. The teens being helped had moved into a high-risk Street Life over a period of time and rarely by their own choice. It takes time, resources, commitment and a personalized step by step approach to help them move off the streets.

Reunification with their families is always a goal; however, over 80% of our homeless teens were sexually and/or physically abused over a period of time before running away. These children do not have the option of returning to a "safe" home.

Sir's Rescue Rangers

This organization is pet partners with Big Paw Rescue which is a 501(c)3 organization. All contributions go to pay veterinarian bills for their groups at Grand Montecito Animal Hospital.
