<b>Camp Lotza Fun</b>	<p><b>Camp Lotza Fun</b> is a summer camp leased and run by the local Chapter 346 of the Lions Club. This camp provides camping and fun activities for needy children</p>
<b>Embracing Project</b>	<p>The leading nonprofit advocate for sexually exploited youth in Clark County. They provide healing services to children and youth who are victims/survivors of sexual exploitation, sex trafficking and violence. The Embracing Project is an offshoot of The Center for Peace.</p>
<b>Eye Care 4 Kids</b>	<p>This non-profit gives free eye exams and glasses for underprivileged children.</p>
<b>Family Promise</b>	<p><b>Family Promise</b> is a community-based approach to solving homelessness, engaging both the local community, as well as, an interfaith network in the effort to combat family homelessness. Guests in our program receive a full complement of resources, support and training as they work towards their own stability and self-reliance.</p>
<b>Forgotten Dog Animal Rescue</b>	<p>This organization responds to callers reporting stray dogs. They place a safe trap for the animal and when captured, they provide medical care, foster homes and eventually permanent homes for unwanted and abandoned dogs.</p>
<b>Hannah's Closet</b>	<p>Hannah's closet supports families in the foster-family network and helps them get clothing and necessary items needed to foster a child.</p>
<b>Horses for Heroes</b>	<p>This Las Vegas based and national non-profit is dedicated to empowering youth, adults and families through interactions and activities involving horses. They provide deeply discounted recreational, instructional and morale-boosting health and wellness programs.</p>
<b>Las Vegas Rescue Mission</b>	<p>The Las Vegas Rescue Mission strives to be the model for providing hope and change to the homeless, addicted, and others in need. They do this through feeding the hungry, sheltering the homeless, and by offering care, support, and an introduction to a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. In the end, they work to provide redemption, recovery, and re-entry to independent living.</p>
<b>Nevada Veteran's Assistance League</b>	<p>This organization was established to meet the ongoing needs of America's heroes who reside at the Southern Nevada Veteran's Home. Gift ensure a sense of security, happiness, dignity, independence and usefulness for residents. Funds are used to purchase things as simple as a haircut, fund outings or buy batteries for an electric wheelchair.</p>
<b>New Vista Ranch</b>	<p>New Vista Ranch homes offer a 24-hour presence with live-in, dedicated staff to assist intellectually challenged individuals with life skills training, medical appointments, and varied social and recreational activities.</p>
<b>Rancho High School: Homeless Student Advocacy</b>	<p>We usually give \$500 twice a year to Rancho kids who have been identified as homeless. In May \$500 is given to seniors, and at Christmas, we buy twenty-five \$20 gift cards for other kids in need at the school.</p>
