| Shine A Light | Helps homeless individuals living in tunnels/underground flood channels. |

| Street Teens | Street Teens is dedicated to assisting homeless, abandoned, and at-risk youth. They provide essential wraparound services in a compassionate environment at their drop-in center servicing youth between the ages of 12 and 21. |

| Foreclosed Upon Pets | No-kill center dedicated to the rescue of domesticated animals that have been abused and/or abandoned. Whether due to economic hardship, loss of job/home, insufficient income, temporary housing of military pets, or death of a pet owner. |
| Hearts Alive Village | No-kill center taking in abandoned pets to shelter until fostered, then placed up for adoption. |
| Pups, Prisoners & Patriots | Remove dogs from high-kill shelters, give to prisoners (non-violent offenders) to train. Dogs then go to vets as therapy/family companions. |
| Seniors to Seniors thru NV SPCA | Senior pets adopted to senior citizens at no-charge. |
