### **VOLUNTEER AND SOCIAL OPPORTUNITIES**

**Bake Sale:** Assist with the Bake Sale and/or supply home-baked goods. This event is normally held the Saturday prior to Thanksgiving.

**Business Expo:** This event is held in June and volunteers assist in setting up, checking-in attendees, answering questions and tracking attendance.

**Craft Fair:** Assist with an event showcasing crafters and their home-crafted items. This event is held in September.

**Operation Santa Claus**: Work with LPWC members to supply Christmas/Hanukkah presents for (a limited number of) local needy families.

**Photographer:** Takes pictures at club events. These pictures are later displayed on the LPWC Bulletin Board inside the clubhouse and/or on the LPWC website.

**Rummage Sale:** Volunteer for one or more days leading up to the sale. During this time, volunteers assist in preparing merchandise and displays. This event is also held in September.

Publicity Committee: Assist in advertising LPWC events and activities.

**Socials Committee:** Help plan and execute LPWC community socials. These events are held two to three times a year at the clubhouse, are open to all residents and their guests and revolve around a theme (i.e. "Halloween Costume Party" or "Spring Fling").
