<b>Compassion Initiative</b>	Distributions with dignity to those in need of food and clothing.
<b>Family Promise</b>	Family Promise is a community-based approach to solving homelessness, engaging both the local community, as well as an interfaith network in the effort to combat family homelessness. Guests in our program receive a full complement of resources, support, and training as they work towards their own stability and self-reliance.
<b>Hannah's Closet</b>	Resource center providing clothing, books, cribs and household items to foster, adoptive and kinship families.
<b>Heroes In the Rough</b>	Serving disabled veterans, offering golf, bowling, various outings to help improve quality of life.
<b>Injured Police Officer's Fund</b>	Helping reduce the financial burden on families of injured or killed officers in the line of duty.
<b>Lighthouse Charities</b>	Empowers refugees to rebuild their lives and contribute to their community.
<b>Las Vegas Catholic Worker</b>	Serves the poor and homeless by cultivating community, teaching non-violence, and providing food for the body and the soul.
<b>Las Vegas Rescue Mission</b>	Serving those in need by providing hope and life-change since 1970. Redemption, Recovery, Restoration.
<b>My True ID</b>	Providing safe, affordable housing and holistic reintegration support for women who have experienced sex trafficking and exploitation.
<b>New Vista</b>	Supports intellectually and developmentally disabled individuals, providing empowering programs to promote independence.
<b>Olive Crest</b>	Provides safe, temporary shelter for at-risk and abused children.
<b>Project Marilyn</b>	Provides feminine hygiene products to homeless women and teens.
<b>Pups, Prisoners and Patriots</b>	Remove dogs from high-kill shelters, give to prisoners (non-violent offenders) to train. Dogs then go to Vets as therapy/companion.
<b>S.A.F.E. House</b>	(Stop Abuse in Family Environment) Provide advocacy and safe shelter to stop abuse in the family environment.
<b>Shine A Light</b>	Helping homeless individuals living in tunnels/underground flood channels.
<b>Street Teens</b>	Street Teens is dedicated to assisting homeless, abandoned, and at-risk youth. They provide essential wraparound services in a compassionate environment at their drop-in center servicing youth between the ages of 12 and 21.
<b>The Mats Project</b>	Making mats for homeless people, including those living in the tunnels of our community.
