**LITTLE PEOPLE OF AMERICA (LPA)** is a nonprofit organization that provides support, information, and education to individuals of short stature and their families. Most of these people have a form of dwarfism, but not all. Little People of America, or LPA, provides new parent support, peer support and mentoring, social interaction, medical support, school and community education, scholarships and grants to its members. Our little people members are individuals that are less than 4'10" but are living in a world made for the average height person. LPA membership ranges from newborns to senior citizens, little people to average height family members and supporters. All people are welcome in LPA, regardless of race, religion, ethnicity, or economic status!

**THE PUGET SOUND CHAPTER OF LPA NEEDS YOUR HELP.** Our annual fundraising auction was scheduled for March 21, 2020 but sadly came to an abrupt halt due to the pandemic. After postponing our event twice, we have decided to host a modified version on July 25th. With the ever-looming potential of the need for another postponement, will move the auction portion of the fundraiser online with a firm July date. All these disappointing changes have resulted in a loss of nearly 50% of our existing donations due to postponements or cancelations. Mariners, Seahawks, Sounders, Huskies and Trailblazer tickets... concert and theater tickets... travel packages...sooo many restaurants...etc. This fundraiser is our sole source of income for the entire year, so we are desperately seeking alternate auction items.
