

OPENING OF SANFORD CAMP DURING COVID 2022 SEASON

The following changes to our normal camp operation due to the covid threat will be followed for the 2022 season:

GENERAL GUIDANCE:

Sign-in: Staff will not be taking temperatures at sign-in. However, parents are instructed to keep their child home if sick. Any sick children will be isolated and sent home immediately by the nurse.

Masks: Each camper is encouraged to come to camp with a mask in his/her backpack. Wearing of masks will be encouraged when indoors, but optional at this time.

Cleaning: Camp facilities will be cleaned and disinfected daily.

Handwashing: Handwashing will be strongly encouraged; counselors will carry hand sanitizer while with a group.

Home-rooms: Each group will be assigned to a classroom for separation from other groups (if necessary) as well as space for rainy days.

Field Trips: Field trips will be limited to older groups to allow for bus spacing; a waterslide will be set up on campus every Friday for those not going to field trips.

Camp Nurse: **A camp nurse will be on duty every day during camp hours to monitor and supervise for covid safety.**
