Friday, April 26, 2024 Dress Rehearsal 5-8pm.

Skaters:

- Arrive at 5pm and get into costume and skates to begin rehearsal at 6:00pm
- Please eat a meal prior to dress rehearsal.
- Get into costumes between 5 and 5:45. Skates on no later than at 5:45 and be ready to skate at 6pm.
- We will run Rio first, then the finale so Frogs, Fireflies and Monkeys can leave after the finale, then we will run the 1st half of the show Mulan, Tina Turner, Top Gun.
- Locker rooms will be assigned. There will be signs on each door indicating who can be inside each room. No changing in the restrooms per SkateSafe regulations.
- Jr. Academy Locker Room 1, LTC Locker Room 2, LTS Locker Room 3, Locker Room 4 Dream Girls
- Please wear your base layer (leotards, tights, etc.) A separate costume email will go out.
- Hair & Makeup instructions and procedure email will go out later this week.
- <u>Learn-to-Skate</u> students will be assigned a "holding area" near the snack bar to watch & wait for their song. Please meet your skater after the rehearsal near the snack bar area downstairs. There will be signs that clearly mark holding areas.
- Special Olympics students will be assigned a "holding area" near the scoreboard end of the rink.
- Bring a jacket, gloves, old towels for feet (helps keep feet dry & clean during costume/skates on & off changes) plus a throw to put on benches for warmth.

*A Note About Spotlights and LED Can Spotlights on Ice | The Importance of Dress Rehearsal

- Skating with three spotlights will feel different at first. This is one reason why dress rehearsal is so important.
- Please tell your skater NOT TO LOOK UP AND DIRECTLY INTO THE SPOTS or into the lights along the boards
 on the audience side. Spots are located above the bleachers upstairs and the new smaller lights will be on the
 audience side on the ice. Looking into the lights WILL BLIND THEM. Look and play to the audience.
- We will run the entire show beginning to end with all costume changes and spotlights and screen on the ice. We will run the finale first, then skaters can leave after their numbers are finished.

Additional items to bring & to do

- Please consider bringing safety pins, bobby pins and tape.
- Please clean your skates and laces to remove marks. Laces should be washed or replaced.

- PARENTS & FRIENDS ARE NOT ALLOWED BACKSTAGE PAST THE CURTAIN IN ENTRANCE AND PAST FENCE
 BY THE RESTROOMS. AFTER THE SHOWS, MEET YOUR SKATER IN THE DESIGNATED AREA, details to follow.
- Snacks Please bring a non-staining shareable snack food item on Saturday that can be shared with skaters and volunteers backstage, a table will be provided in front of the mural wall. Rink will provide hot chocolate.
- Skater should still bring their own water bottle.
- Please remind your skater to hydrate & eat before & during dress rehearsal and shows as it is a very long day, a
 snack table will be provided with snacks. *Drinks such as Body Armor are low in sugar and provide necessary
 electrolytes and will help sustain your skater.
- Please be patient during rehearsal as there are many moving parts such as setup, props, curtain, etc.
- All costumes must be hung back up in their designated locker rooms.
- Hair & Makeup instructions will go out later this week.

Pre-Show Set Up & After Show Tear-Down Volunteers & Procedures

- Pre-show Volunteers, please arrive no later than 5 pm or earlier if you have been asked.
- Our hope is that all participants and families stay for 30 minutes after the show to help with tear-down of the set.
- All costumes must be hung back up in their designated locker rooms after each show.
