- Buy needed equipment as soon as possible
- Attend weekly practices with your athlete
- Be able to help with fundraising activities

  - Pull targets
  - Pick-up spent shells
  - Monitor safety
- Wear ear protection
- Be willing to pursue private coaching when needed
- Exhibit good sportsmanship and attitude
- Join one of the Team Committees to help lead team responsibilities
