Basic Fee Schedule

Please note, our services are specific to each individual case. We will be happy to discuss your horse's specific needs & requirements. Our facility is committed to successful recovery of every horse that enters our barn.

Each horse is required to complete a 2 week quarantine before being eligible for turnout.

Daily Lay Up/Stall Board - \$40/day.

(Includes grain, hay, bedding & daily stall cleaning. Turnout if needed/applicable.)

Extended Stall Rest - \$500/mo.

(Includes hay, grain, bedding, and daily stall cleaning. Turnout if needed/applicable. Basic daily monitoring & communication with referring clinician as liaison for care.)

Medication Administration - \$10/day (Ophthalmic, \$20/day)

(Includes feed-through or oral medication administration. Additional handling fees may apply for horses who may be a challenge to treat. Up to 2x daily medication.)

Wound Care/Rebandaging - Quoted per case.

(We can provide wound care supplies & rebandaging services as needed.)
