## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Special Area (music, gym) additional requirements will be distributed individually once school starts

**Physical Education Uniforms:** Students are expected to have a CMS PE uniform and tennis shoes to wear in class each day. Each child will be given a locker with a built in combination lock to secure these items. During the first week of school, we use class time to allow students to purchase their uniforms. **Uniforms cost \$20** and there is a space on both the t-shirt and shorts for your child to write their name. We expect that everyone will have their **uniform by Monday, September 11<sup>th</sup>**. Uniforms can be worn for more than one year as long as it continues to fit your child properly.
