# Early Money Maker

Elon Reeve Musk was born into a wealthy South African family in 1971. He learned to make money early and it seemed to be a very natural ability. When he was just 12 years old, he made and sold his first video game for \$500. While in college at the University of Pennsylvania, he gave big parties that guests had to buy tickets for. After college he borrowed \$28K from his father to start a company with his brother and a friend (Zip2). A few years later, Musk sold Zip2 to Compaq for \$307 million usd. Elon got \$22m. So, from a \$28K loan, Elon Musk made \$22m. Not bad, right? Well that's what King Midas does. Everything he touches turns to gold.

## Online Banking

Musk then invested \$12m to begin *X.com*, one of the first online banks. X.com changed its name to PayPal. When EBay bought PayPal in 2003, Musk received \$175.8m. So, from an investment of \$12m, Elon "Midas" Musk received \$175.8m. Again, not bad at all. Musk seemed to have a gift of seeing what would be popular in the future and investing in it.

#### Life Drama

Yes, Elon had a gift for making money. But his personal life hasn't been as simple. Musk has at least 10 children (maybe more). He and his first wife had twins and then triplets, then divorced in 2008. His oldest daughter changed her last name and wants nothing to do with him. He married and divorced the same British woman twice. In 2018, his girlfriend, Grimes, gave birth to their first son. They had another child after they broke up. ### Tesla

Musk is well known for his involvement with **Tesla**, makers of electric cars. Tesla was founded in 2003 by 2 US engineers. They wanted to make an electric car that *performed* as well as a gas-powered car. In 2005, Musk invested \$6.5m and became the major *stockholder* and a product designer.



#### **Twitter**

Twitter, currently called "X," was introduced to the public in July 2006. It grew quickly and had 200 million regular monthly users by 2012. In 2022, Musk purchased Twitter for 44 billion usd. He said that his goal in his buying Twitter was to encourage free speech. But, many people use Twitter to spread hate speech and misinformation. In the United States, freedom of speech is an important privilege.

# Space X
