

Thank you all for your dedication and support. Let's carry this momentum into the next quarter and continue our mission with pride!






MONTHLY NEWS

CHAPTER MEETING


We move our monthly meetings around the area and *At Ease Campground and Marina* kindly hosted us for May.





This quarter we also went out and supported our local Vietnam Veteran Museum, aka The Bunker, for one of their fundraising events.






