6-year-old Stella Schultz, daughter of Matt and Karrie Schultz, resides in Jerseyville, IL. Stella was diagnosed with mutation, PPA2, which causes spontaneous heart failure and typically results in death prior to the age of 2.

In 2023 Stella, a typical 4-year-old, exhibited flu-like symptoms that led to a heart failure diagnosis. She was airlifted to SLCH and placed on ECMO for 13 days, during which a gene mutation (PPA2) was discovered, making her eligible for a heart transplant. Although her condition deteriorated after ECMO, she underwent an 8-hour surgery to implant a ventricular device while waiting for a donor heart. Just before her 5th birthday, she received a heart transplant and spent 254 days in the hospital before returning home.
