In 1935, neighbors living on top of Mt Tamalpais banded together to get the County of Marin to pave Panoramic Highway. Their success lead to several initiatives and projects (still in effect today) geared toward making Mt. Tam safe and enjoyable.


This year, the Muir Woods Park Community Association celebrates 90 years of fellowship, fire & weather safety, community activities and civic endeavors. Most of all, we feel connected to one another in unique ways, living in and amongst nature.



In the late 1940's, we purchased land on a ridge with 360° views of the entire Bay Area. Volunteers built a clubhouse that today is the center of our community.

For us 'community' has become more than a catch phrase. Today we've come together in new ways, offering a place to talk, to plan and to work towards service. On most Sundays we have a volunteer-run café serving food prepared by neighbors, and friends & visitors to Mt. Tam will pop in to take in the views, listen to music and enjoy homemade fare.

We'll be celebrating the treasured history of our community with a jamboree on **Saturday, July 26** from **11am-5pm**, featuring two old-time & bluegrass bands ([Easy Winners](#) and [Lickety Split](#)), a barbecue, a pie contest, a raffle, kite-flying, local officials celebrating our club, old-timers with tales of life on the Mountain, and a very special exhibit of historic photographs and original Mt Tam paintings from California Impressionist [Tilden Daken](#) (1876-1935).


