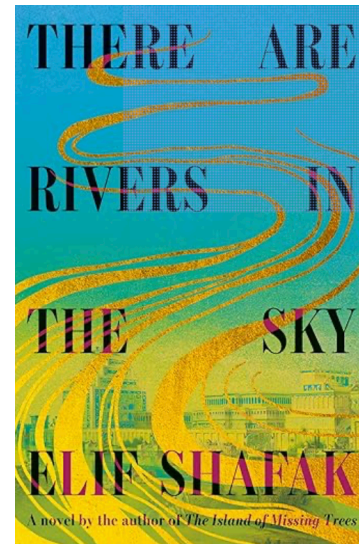
This month's book choice is ***There Are Rivers in the Sky*** by Elif Shafak
