### Two Free Chipper Days Provided by Marin County Fire Department

Thanks to funds provided by the Marin Wildfire Protection Agency (MWPA) and sourced by senior management at the Throckmorton Fire Station, this neighborhood is being granted two opportunities to get dangerous fuel off the Mountain. Now is the time to remove unwanted brush from properties and bring them to the lower lot of the MWPCA Clubhouse at 40 Ridge on Sunday September 10th and Sunday October 8th from 10 am until 4 pm. Throckmorton fire personnel will be on hand to assist and to answer questions regarding fire safety. **Note:** No hazardous materials, lumber or branches larger than 8" in diameter are accepted at these events.

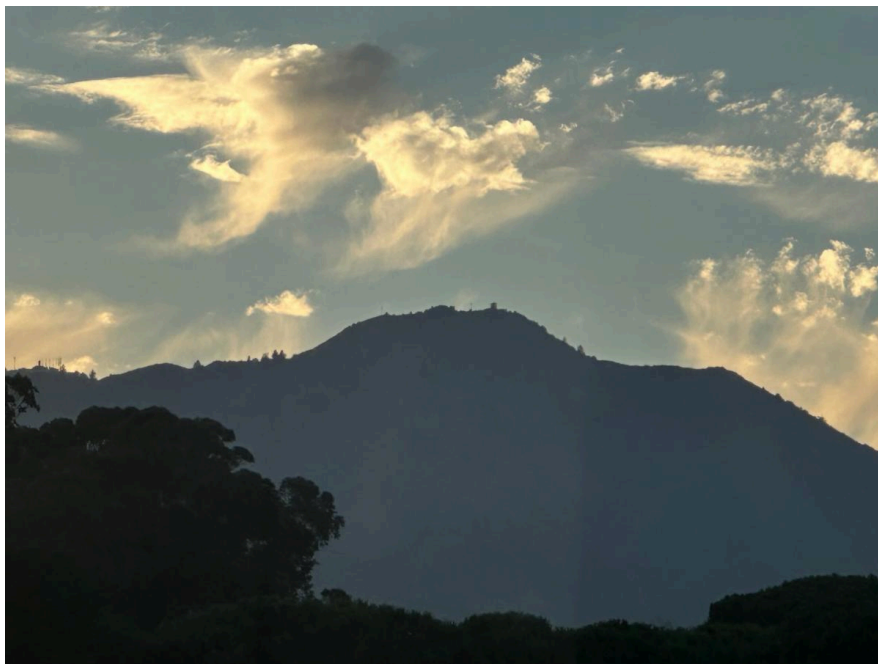
## Mountain Emergency Team Update
