The fire-grazing goats of Lost Emu Farms are coming to work on our hillside, and we're turning their visit into a free community Fire Safety & Clothing Swap event.

Come meet the goats (4:30 - 5:30pm) and join Rebecca Burgess of Fibershed and Herder Billie to explore how what we wear connects to the way we tend our land, and how both can play a role in wildfire resilience (5:30 - 7:00pm).

Then stay for our natural fiber clothing swap. Bring clean clothing made from 100% natural fibers -- wool, cotton, linen, silk, hemp, cashmere, alpaca and more. You'll receive one ticket for every item you bring and can trade it for something new-to-you.

Come for the goats. Stay for the swap. Leave with a new appreciation for what's grazing on the hillside—and possibly a sweater.
