Neighborhood Chipping in November!

The Marin Wildfire Prevention Authority has just added a neighborhood chipping opportunity for our area. Please see this link for more information - you MUST register to take advantage of this offer.

Marin Wildfire Protection Agency Fire Safety Programs in Full Gear Captain Aaron Jarvis of the Marin County Fire Department shared some great news about fire safety projects that have been approved in our area. The first project is a cutting and piling project over a 75-acre area all on State Parks land. Tam Crews completed work in about 5 acres of the project last November and they are planning to re-start work this month. They will likely start this year's work around the ranger house on Panoramic. The second project is funded by the MWPA for roadside clearance on all roads in the County Service Area in our region. This project will generally cover pruning tree limbs vertically up to around 15' and removing small diameter trees and brush along road edges. In addition, the County has engaged Clements Tree Company to remove any Juniper or Cypress Trees which are highly flammable. Contact County Fire at 415.275.1185 for more information.


