mwPCA is officially looking for help

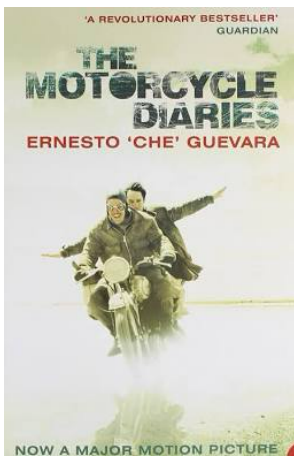

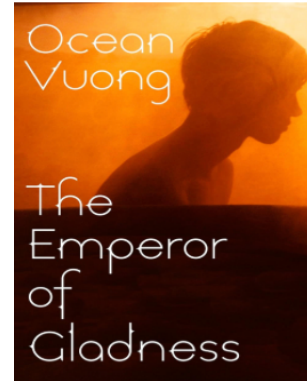
