Get your tickets at the gallery desk during the Reception!

Take-in for the last judged show of the season, "Skilled" is on Sunday, April 30th!

The gallery is open all year, so again we will be having exhibitions this summer. These are in the planning stages, so they will be announced. Typically the take-in for the summer show is on the same day as the pick-up from the last show... so that will not change. We want to keep our gallery full of art at all times!

#### IMPORTANT NOTICE

#### When wiring your pieces for the gallery show please remember:

The hardware to hold the wires should be placed 1/3 of the way down on each side of the piece. The wire when attached to the hardware on each side should be slack enough to be approximately two inches below the top of the piece when held up in the center. Test it out: Hang the piece on a wall. If the piece leans forward and/or the wire and picture hook shows, the piece is not wired correctly. Adjust it. *Improperly wired pieces may be disqualified for show entry.* 

**BEFORE** you come to the gallery for take-in make sure your piece is wired correctly. That the ends of the wires are taped. That your piece is labeled with your name, title of work, media, price and phone number and that label is attached in the upper right hand corner on the back of the work.
