The Lake Worth Street Painting Festival is scheduled to return this coming February. For many years we have held an outdoor tent and table show in our east parking lot while the festival is going on. This has proven to be successful not only for the LWAL but also for our members both in and outside of the gallery as this festival draws thousands of folks to the Lake and Lucerne Avenue downtown areas every year.

As in the past, these spaces will be on a first come, first serve basis. The spots are free, however, we must ask for a \$100. deposit to hold the space. The deposit is refundable to those that do show on both days, or if we are notified well in advance of a cancellation. Deposits of no-shows or without advance notification are retained by the LWAL.

20% of all sales go to the LWAL in lieu of charging for the space. This is a great opportunity for our members.
