DRAWING CLASSES WITH DARCY DOIEL



Darcy Doiel, is an award winning artist and instructor with a Bachelor's Degree in Fine Art. She will be teaching four, three hour classes on Wednesday mornings in this session. The content of the material she covers in her classes are progressive in order so it is important that each class is attended. You must sign up for the entire session of four classes as individual classes are not offered. Her class begins on February 1st.

WATERCOLOR CLASSES WITH ED BIANCHI



This class is geared towards beginner and intermediate students looking to learn and build upon the fundamentals of watercolor painting. By the end of the course, you will have been exposed to all of the components necessary to develop your own painting style. The session consists of four, three hour classes on Wednesday afternoons, beginning February 1st. Ed Bianchi attended the prestigious Art Students League of New York where he trained under Jerry N. Weiss. Ed had the privilege to participate in numerous juried art shows where oftentimes was awarded first place in watercolor.

OIL OR ACRYLIC CLASSES WITH LYNN PETERSON



Award winning artist Lynn Peterson will offer a 3 hour class in oil or acrylic for beginners to intermediate students on four Saturdays. The classes begin on February 4th. Her instruction offers personal attention to each student and a weekly critique. To give her student the best experience possible there is a limit 10 students per class. Lynn holds a BFA degree.

Entry fees for judged shows:

\$25.00 for first entry

\$15.00 for additional entries
 up to 5 pieces total.

Every artist must host the gallery for at least
one shift per show*

Dues must be current.

All pieces entered must be ready for hanging
 according to our specifications or
 they will not be hung.

Payments may be made by check or credit card.
 Credit card payments are subject to a processing fee by
 the card company.

* A fee of \$30.00 per shift may be paid at take-in if an artist is physically unable to sit. Members may trade hosting dates with another member if something comes up. Otherwise we have a "no excuses" policy except for a bona fide emergency. Fines will be incurred.
