# A Message from the Board of Directors

Dear Members,

We would like to update our members on what has taken place while the gallery was closed due to the virus.

Our lease was up for renewal, and included an increase in the rent. After careful consideration and discussion the lease was renewed.

To help minimize the impact from this increase it was decided to not renew the rental of the storage space along side of the building. The space was not air-conditioned, and so only certain items could safely be stored there. Upon reviewing the contents of this space, we felt that we could absorb items that were considered to be necessary to the LWAL into the gallery itself. There were many items in storage that belong to individual members. We regret that we can no longer store these items. These items have been temporarily relocated to the special exhibition room in the gallery. These items must be removed by the owners in a timely manner so that we may make use of our gallery space, and not turn this space into another storage area. Items that have been left in the gallery itself also must be removed.

**Donations:** At this time, the LWAL will take only donations of books and DVD's that are instructional in nature. Please do not drop off any other type of books. We also will no longer be able to accept artwork for donation or art frames or easels. We hope to set up a member artist to member artist donation box for small art supplies only in the near future.

Receptions: As some of you may know, our receptions were held on Sunday afternoons for many years. We then began to hold them on first Friday evenings in conjunction with the City of Lake Worth first Friday events. This was in the hopes that we would attract more folks to the receptions. This idea was somewhat successful however, it placed a hardship on our members as well as those working the reception. We will hold our Nov. show reception on Friday, for member's only. Beginning in December, we will revert to holding our receptions on Sunday afternoons from 1 to 3 pm. With the exception of one Saturday reception due to a holiday. Please see the schedule on page 3.

**COVID-19:** When sitting the gallery you must wear a mask until the Palm Beach County mask mandate is lifted for all businesses. Social distancing is also required. Visitors to the gallery must wear a mask to enter the gallery.

Our visitors usually come in, walk around to view the art, and most often leave without touching anything, making us safer than most businesses.

We have removed the blue chairs and spaced a few folding chairs spaced well apart. If visitors sit for a bit, these chairs can be wiped down easier than the blue ones.

Those that sit the gallery are urged to wipe down the front entry door handle, inside and outside, after each guest and at the end of the day, as well as the backdoor handles and entry keypad. Handles to the restroom, toilet seat and flush handle should be wiped down after use.

Please bring your hand sanitizer for yourself and your own masks, and gloves if you wish to wear them. The boutique is open, however, inform guests that if they wish to examine something further, you will be happy to show the item to them.
