

The Harry J. Wamboldt Scholarship

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

Each year, the S.C. International Trade Conference presents scholarships to students in memory of Harry J. Wamboldt, who was instrumental in growth of international manufacturing in South Carolina. Harry served on various non-profit boards in the low country as well as statewide. In 2024, three scholarships of \$2,000 each were awarded to outstanding high school seniors.

An applicant must be a **2025 graduating high school senior** with a minimum 3.0 overall GPA in high school. In addition, applicants must also be either: (1) a South Carolina resident, or (2) planning to attend an accredited South Carolina college, university, or trade school to study International Trade, Supply Chain Management, Business, Manufacturing, Engineering or Science.

The selection and ranking criteria, in order of importance, are:

- Demonstrated interest in International Trade, Supply Chain Management, Business, Manufacturing, Engineering or Science;
- Current academic standing and performance (must be a graduating high school senior with a minimum 3.0 overall GPA);
- Narrative and letter of recommendation; and
- Honors and extracurricular activities.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS & GUIDELINES

Eligible applicants must meet the criteria on the preceding page and must include the following: (1) a Completed Nomination/Application Form (below); (2) a High School Transcript(s) to include cumulative GPA; (3) a Brief Narrative explaining why you should receive the scholarship; and (4) One Written Recommendation from a teacher or guidance counselor at your high school.

Applications must be received no later than <u>May 31st, 2025</u>. Recipients will be announced by July 1st, 2025.
