Approval of November 2023 Meeting Minutes with no changes.

Variance Application VAR 1-24 reviewed for a Pole Barn/Garage over 750 sq.ft. with a front setback of 50 feet. The board discussed with the resident the hardship that comes from trying to move the Pole Barn/garage and back further. There is heavily wood land behind it and a nice drop off that would not allow for him to move it back the required 25 feet to meet the front setbacks. SEQR application reviewed and it has been determined, based on the information and analysis of any supporting documentation that the proposed action will not result in any significant adverse environment impacts. Public Hearing opened at 7:13pm. The Cinfranco's asked what was needed for the variance. Pole Barn style garage over 750 sq ft with the front set back at 50'.
