Old Business:

Re-discussion for SEQR form pertaining to the Curtain Dairy subdivision SD 1-25 to clarify the archeological questions that were changed in the previous meeting. The questions were answered correctly and should not have been changed. The board agreed to move forward and approve the SEQR with the clarification. Public Hearing for SD 1-25 opened at 7:03pm. No discussion, questions, or comments made from the public or the board. Public hearing closed for SD 1-25 at 7:04pm. SD 1-25 was approved with no conditions.
