Description:

As a Host Home Provider, you will offer a nurturing and supportive home-like environment for adults who require assistance with daily living activities. This role involves integrating an Ability United Member into your family unit and community, providing a personalized and caring alternative to traditional residential care settings. You will play a pivotal role in enhancing the quality of life for the Member you host, supporting their independence, and fostering their involvement in community activities.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide a safe, welcoming, and inclusive living environment for the Member.
- Assist with daily living activities, including but not limited to, personal care, medication management, and mobility support.
- Coordinate and provide transportation for appointments, social activities, and other necessary outings.
- Plan and prepare meals considering dietary needs and preferences.
- Facilitate and encourage the Member's engagement with the community.
- Collaborate with care teams to implement personalized care plans, attending to the physical, emotional, and social needs of the Member.
- Maintain regular communication with the agency, updating them on the Member's progress and any concerns or needs that may arise.
- Conduct and maintain daily documentation of the Member's health, activities, and overall well-being, ensuring accurate records are maintained.

- A compassionate, patient, and understanding demeanor.
- Ability to provide a stable and nurturing home environment.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Ability to work flexibly and respond to changing needs.
- Commitment to promoting independence and integration in the community.
- Must pass a background check and meet agency home safety standards.
