ORDINANCE NO. 2025-06

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE OPERATION OF "STREET-LEGAL SPECIAL PURPOSE VEHICLES" AS DEFINED BY KRS CHAPTER 186 ON HIGHWAYS AND STREETS IN THE CITY OF Corydon AND ESTABLISHING RESTRICTIONS FOR OPERATION**

WHEREAS, the Kentucky General Assembly passed Senate Bill 63 to authorize local governments to adopt ordinances to allow "street-legal special purpose vehicles" as defined by KRS Chapter 186 to operate upon highways within its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 63 contains equipment requirements for and restricts operation of "street-legal special purpose vehicles" on all highways, including those in local governments that allow operation by ordinance;

WHEREAS, the city of Corydon determines that the operation of "street-legal special purpose vehicles" on authorized highways is beneficial to the city and its residents;

WHEREAS, the city of Corydon reserves its right to impose additional restrictions on the operation of "street-legal special purpose vehicles";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF Corydon, KENTUCKY, as follows:

**A. DEFINITIONS as used in this Ordinance shall have the following meaning:**

- (1) "Cabinet" means the Kentucky Department of Transportation;
- (2) "Highway" shall have the same meaning as defined in KRS 186 (2);
- (3) "Prohibited equipment" means any equipment installed on a street-legal special purpose vehicle that is prohibited by state law or city ordinance;
- (2) "Street-legal special purpose vehicle" shall have the same meaning as defined in Senate Bill 63 as codified in KRS Chapter 186;

**B. AUTHORIZED USE**

- (1) Effective June 27, 2025, "street-legal special purpose vehicles" as defined by Senate Bill 63 and codified in KRS Chapter 186 shall be authorized to operate on the highways within the city of Corydon.
- (2) Operation of "street-legal special purpose vehicles" as defined by Senate Bill 63 and codified in KRS Chapter 186 shall be subject to state law requirements and restrictions.

**C. MISCELLANEOUS**

- (1) If any part of this Ordinance is held unconstitutional or unenforceable, the remaining parts shall remain in force and effect.
