## ORDINANCE 2017.03 AN ORDINANCE ADMENDING SECTION 130.02 OF THE CITY OF CORYDON CODE OF ORDINANCES

SUMMARY: This Ordinance amends Section 130.02 of the City of Corydon Code of Ordinances to remove the provision allowing the City Council to issue permits for discharge of firearms for special occasions.

WHEREAS, Section 130.02 of the City of Corydon Code of Ordinances prohibits the discharge of a firearm within the city limits subject to certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Corydon believes it to be in the best interest of the City to amend the Section 130.02 by deleting Section 130.02(C); and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Corydon that Section 130.02 of the City of Corydon Code of Ordinances is amended as follows (information added is underlined and information deleted is identified with a strike through):

## 130.02 DISCHARGING FIREARMS.

- (A) For the purpose of this section, "<u>FIREARM</u>" means any weapon which will expel a projectile by the action of an explosive.
- (B) Except as hereinafter provided, it shall be unlawful for any person to shoot or discharge a firearm within the city limits. This section shall not apply to any peace officer who discharges a firearm in the performance of his duties or to any person who discharges a firearm while lawfully defending person or property.
- (C) The City Council may issue permits to discharge firearms on special occasions upon such conditions as the City Council may deem reasonable.
- (ĐC) Any person who shall violate the provisions of this section shall be fined not less than \$10 nor more than \$100 and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which the violation occurs or continues.
