

**CITY OF CORYDON
ORDINANCE NO. 2013-03**

**AN ORDINANCE INCREASING SEWER RATES FOR THE USE OF THE
SEWER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF CORYDON, KENTUCKY**

WHEREAS, the City of Corydon operates a sewage collection and transportation system to provide adequate service for the city and to meet water quality requirements as outlined by PL92-500 and its amendments; and

WHEREAS, the system must produce enough annual revenue to offset all annual costs; and

WHEREAS, the costs shall be fairly proportioned among all users according to waste load and flow characteristics; and

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2012, the Corydon City Council, by unanimous vote, determined that the then effective monthly rate did not produce adequate annual revenue to recover the City's cost of operation and maintenance and that rates should be increased in two phases, The first to be effective April 1, 2012, and the second to be effective April 1, 2013 herein; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Corydon as follows:

I. The March 12, 2012, action of the Corydon City Council, increasing sewer rates, is hereby ratified, and affirmed only as to the first phase increased and affirmed as set forth herein.

II. Effective, April 1, 2012, the sewer rates for each Residential and Commercial Customer and A.B. Chandler School shall be increased by 12 ½% (calculated on the rates effective immediately prior to the April 1, 2012 increase). With the increase, the monthly sewer rates effective April 1, 2012, shall be as follows:

III. Research 12 ½% increases is hereby nullified and shall not take effect without any further action without the Corydon City council. :

IV. The validity of any section, clause, sentence, or provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

V. This ordinance and its provisions shall be valid for all service areas, under the jurisdiction of the City of Corydon, Kentucky, by fact or by Agreement.

VI. That this ordinance shall take effect after its passage on second and final reading and publication as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CORYDON, AS FOLLOWS:

This Ordinance shall be effective upon its legal adoption.
