The idea of a day dedicated to mothers in America was first proposed by Anna Jarvis in 1908, a year after her mother's death. She wanted to honor her mother's lifelong devotion to caring for the sick and promoting peace. Anna organized the first Mother's Day celebration at a Methodist church in West Virginia, where her mother had taught Sunday school.



Mr. Potato Head is a classic toy that was first introduced on May 1st, 1952, by Hasbro. It was the first toy to be advertised on television and was originally intended be used with real potatoes.

The kit came with plastic parts such as eyes, noses, and mouths that could be stuck into a potato to create a face. In 1964, Hasbro began including a plastic potato body with the kit, which eliminated the need for a real potato. Over the years, Mr. Potato Head has become a beloved children's toy and has even appeared in movies and TV shows.




