Wedding Packages

**The packages are based on average guest count. We offer several amenities. The packages are all inclusive to make pricing straightforward.

Wedding budgets are complex, so we hope to simplify the experience.

Bella Bolettino only hosts about 8 events a year, four in the spring and four in the fall. We dedicate an entire weekend to a couple so that they can enjoy the rehearsal dinner on Friday and the wedding on Saturday. We also include two nights in our four-bedroom two-bath Airbnb that is across North River Road from the farm for the Friday and Saturday of your wedding. The vacation rental is listed on the Airbnb website under "Vino Cabina". You can link to it on our website as well. https://bellabolettinofarms.com/

- 1. Rehearsal dinner, usually scheduled for a Friday, we can supply the tablecloths for this event if desired.
- 2. The wedding (Saturday) includes the reception.
- 3. Our package would also include two nights in Vino Cabina, more nights could be reserved if requested. This also serves as dressing room space for the bridal party. If the bride and bridal party want to dress at the farm to avoid wrinkling dresses, we have a guest bedroom and loft area and a large balcony for dressing on the day of the wedding.
- 4. The venue includes enough tables and chairs to seat 200, but a few tables would need to spill onto the lawn, 175 or below tends to be the most comfortable for guest seating.
- 5. A Day of Coordinator is included. Shauna meets with the couple two to three times before the wedding. She will discuss décor, seating, vendors, etc. She will direct the rehearsal and coordinate the day of schedule, liaison with vendors, and Bella Bolettino staff. ***If you have a Wedding Planner, Shauna functions in a supportive role. We have worked several Event Planners in the area.
- 6. Parking and wait/serving/hostess staff of 8 to 12 people depending on the size of the wedding. Our staff are dressed in uniforms, so they are easy to identify. Staff are on two-way radios. The staff serve in the role of back up to caterers, bartending/bar back, guest relations, and shuttle guests to and from their cars.
- 7. The farm has dinnerware, flatware, water goblets, wine glasses, champagne flutes, mason jars for beer, glass water decanters for each table, large glass water and lemonade decanters, coffee (if requested). We have three different colors of chargers (copper, silver, and bronze).
- 8. We can supply ivory full-length tablecloths. We have 60-inch tables that seat eight; the ivory tablecloths are floor-length. Black linens for cocktail/bistro, buffet, and bar tables.
- 9. We have one to two golf carts to shuttle guests to and from their cars. A variety of décor items (vases, candle holders, place holders, wooden tree slabs, shepherd hooks, etc.). Please talk with Shauna about specific inventory items.

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- 10. The staff will do the set-up and breakdown of tables, chairs, dishes, and flatware, we can also assist with decorating when requested. Staff will manage parking, set up, bartending/bar back, serving food, or busing as needed. They will also help with breaking down and supporting other vendors.
- 11. A large walk-in cooler (12 x 16) is available for flowers, drinks, food, etc. You can bring things a couple of days ahead to make the day less stressful.
- 12. Yard games (corn hole, ladder, etc.)
- 13. You are welcome to leave items after the reception to be picked up the next day if that is easier. You can leave items earlier in the week to make it less stressful the day of the rehearsal dinner or later.

Additional Info:

- You can hire whatever caterer, food truck, or chef that you prefer.
- We do have a prep kitchen that most local caterers and some chefs have used. Please review our Preferred Vendors list for ideas.
- We are not a winery, we are an organic peach orchard, so that allows you to purchase your own alcohol, have a liquor store provide the alcohol, hire a traveling bartender with a bar trailer, or have our staff serve, etc.
- We encourage wedding parties to consider purchasing local wine and local beer. If you hire a professional bartender, we do not have an issue with hard liquor. Without a professional bartender, we limit hard alcohol to a premade signature cocktail during the cocktail hour only. Due to insurance restrictions, alcohol must be purchased by whoever signs the contract: therefore, any guest who brings alcohol to the wedding or reception will be asked to leave and their alcohol will be given to the bride and groom to return to them.
- We do not allow fireworks or sparklers.
- We request any flower petals dropped by flower girls be actual petals, nothing artificial.
- We strongly encourage recyclable tableware if not using our dishware and glassware. Bamboo can be a good option. We will recycle all wine bottles, cans, etc. Any bamboo plates will compost. A good option for keg beer are the aluminum cups that can be recycled.
