We are committed to give quality and safety training to our valued customers/patrons.

We are following the guidelines set out through our governments and AHS.

We are also following guidelines through our franchise agencies.

We are doing our part to provide service during a very trying time for our community and give our personal assurance that we are serious in minimizing contact during the Covid 19 situation we are experiencing in 2020.

Listed below are some of the measures we are taking during this pandemic.

Screening offered:

- 1) Upon booking for classes- staff screen students, direct them to AHS Self-Assessment online.
- 2) Reminder call for classes- staff screen students again.
- 3) Upon arrival- signage is posted to inform students. Hand sanitizer at entry of building posted mandatory to use before continuing upstairs to reception. Completion of screening form complete with contact information (hard copy) is completed along with registration form and kept onsite with course records.
- 4) Visual observation
- 5) Temperature scan monitor available

As this is a training facility, contact information is already obtained from students (with consent).

Small family run business- all staff are from the same family cohort. None of the staff have young children they will require caring for if ill. Staff schedule is maintained with the training calendar- set monthly.

Distancing Measures:

-No physical touching between students during training (as per St. John Ambulance, Energy Safety Canada,

And Global Training Centre as franchise providers/ protocols and AHS).

-Mask Required upon entry into facility and at all times while in facility

- staff maintain 6 Feet distance from students at all times.

-Current AHS Required Spacing 1 student/desk unless from same household) Individual station with provided sanitized items for training.

-Staff members are of the same household- thus distancing between staff is not required.

Cleaning considerations:

After each class, all high touch surfaces (doors, railings, bathrooms, desks, chairs and walls in classrooms) are cleaned using cleaning solution (spray nine or isopropyl) and disinfected using Chlorine Bleach solution (classroom) or Lysol wipes (bathroom).

Every 2-3 hours, and at the end of the day high touch surfaces are sprayed with Bleach water solution. Also offer Lysol wipes for individuals to use if they choose for personal assurance.

First Aid/CPR mannequins/ resuscitation and AED equipment are cleaned and disinfected after each use with chlorine bleach solution and air dried.

All hard surface equipment (including air supply masks) are cleaned and disinfected with Isopropyl alcohol spray (70%) including SCBAs and Mannequins.

PPE considerations:

For Staff and students/patrons:

- Disposable gloves are provided
- Hand sanitizer and facial tissue is provided for students and staff (on each desk)
- Masks required at all time in facility
- staff maintains a 6 foot distance from students at all times.

Staff members are of the same household- thus distancing between staff is not required.

Precautions provided:

Staff shared cleaning duties, whom ever is not teaching completes disinfection throughout the day, and at end of day. staff share the cleaning/disinfecting duties.

Checklist onsite completed daily.

We make our best effort to be compliant with the most recent information we are given by our directives.

If we make modifications it will be to enhance or meet the new changes in requirements as set out by authorities.
