Everyone is invited to a potluck lunch after worship on April 28th! Please bring a dish to share. A good time will be had by all!


Worship

Save the Date and plan to join us for the end of the school year Spring Fling and Family Picnic on May 15th at 10:30. We hope to see you all there.



The Spring Festival was on March 16th. Thank you to everyone who helped make it a huge success!

Our church would like to have groups go help at Montlure camp in Greer, AZ. There are two weekends to choose from: April 26-28 or May 17-19.

Throughout the years, Montlure has had groups of volunteers continually maintain and make needed repairs to the camp. Now with the effort to return campers home in 2024, we have many tasks and projects that will have to happen to make camp safe and ready for campers. For Spring of 2024, some of the projects to complete include:

- Restore electric to Bathhouse and Porcupine Cabin
- Replace a water heater
- Revamp Nurse's cabin/repair railing
- Kitchen/equipment up to code
- Add additional bathroom/shower facility
- Restore pathways
- Repair/Replace window and coverings
- Build fencing for USFS mitigation
- Drainage mitigation work
- Sewer line work
- Resurface concrete on basketball court
- Other general construction/repair projects
- Deep cleaning projects and much more!



We need skilled construction and trades; please let us know of your abilities when you sign up. However, we also need deep cleaners, odds and ends general repairs, and a few people at each work camp to prepare meals. There is something for everyone!

While work camps are at no cost to participants, for those who are able, we ask for a minimum donation of \$50 per person to our Friends of Montlure fund to help cover the utility and supply costs for all work camps. If interested in going on one or both weekends, please let Susan Chesko or Mike Gerlach know.

Community dinners will be served during the summer months on the first Wednesday of June, July and August. We will open Fellowship Hall at 4:00 p.m. for people to come in out of the heat, but the meal will be served at 5:00 p.m.

We will be putting together Blessing Bags to hand out to the homeless around the valley. A list of items needed will be available the week of April 15th and donations for this mission can be made through May 1st in the office or at church on Sundays.
