Property Update

The Roof

- The chapel/fellowship hall roof replacement project was completed successfully.
- We added air conditioning mounts to the Christian education wing so we can cool the library and youth areas more efficiently.
- Everyone is very happy with the results and no more leaks!

The Parking Lot

- The roofing job highlighted the weak condition of the parking lot pavement. Heavy trucks dug out some good potholes which had to be filled.
- Everyone has noticed the many cracks and holes, faded parking lines, and lack of lighting. Time to do something about it.
- It has been discussed for a long time, but now it is a safety issue. Plus it looks unwelcoming to visitors. The job would involve completely removing the existing pavement and replacing it with a new layer of asphalt.

The Cost

- The ballpark figure is \$250,000. A few paving companies have come out to look at it and are providing detailed bids, although no bid has been chosen yet.
- We are starting a capital campaign to raise these funds and ask you to prayerfully consider helping us pay for this.
- Checks can be mailed in or dropped off at the church office. Remember to specify "capital campaign" on the memo line.

We will keep you posted on how we're doing toward our goal. Thank you again for supporting this beautiful church. — Dave Frederick
