There will be "many happy returns" this summer and fall! The Good Lord willing, choirs will return this fall! During the summer, the Sanctuary Choir will sing in worship a couple of times (July

25th and August 29th), and beginning with Kickoff Sunday, September 12th, all choirs will reconvene! We will begin with limited numbers, with others returning as comfort levels rise. All choirs will rehearse in the Sanctuary (where we have a large space and high ceiling!), and rehearsals will be shorter than normal. Things will look a bit different, but it will be a welcome sight, and it will be great to be back!
