A Message from Brant

Why go to church on Sunday mornings?

A recent survey by the Barna Group (March 25, 2014) asked Americans what, if anything helps them grow in their faith. People offered a variety of answers—prayer, family or friends, reading the Bible, having children—but going to church did not even crack the top-10 list. Although going to church was once a mainstay of American life, adults today are almost evenly divided on the question, with about half saying church attendance is important, while the other half say it isn't.

Worship may ground us, grow us, or gratify us, but ultimately it's not about us at all.

What I find interesting is the "me-centeredness" of both the question and the answers. Worship isn't about having us grow spiritually (although sometimes we do, and that's always nice), or about having us feel better (ditto), or even about what we get out of it (about as much as you put into it). Worship is about bringing God our thanks and praise. It's about acknowledging that everything we are, and everything we have, comes from God's gracious hand. Worship may ground us, grow us, or gratify us ("Wasn't the choir great today?!"), but ultimately it's not about us at all.

Those of us involved in our worship here at FPC work pretty hard to bring quality, honor, and joy to what we do each week. But of course doing so runs the risk that in our entertainment-oriented culture, people too often start asking the wrong

questions and having incorrect assumptions. If you are one who has slipped away from regular worship, I would invite you to examine yourself: have you made worship more about yourself and less about giving honor to God? Have you treated worship as a duty rather than as a privi-

lege ("What, I get to stand before the Maker of the Universe??!!")? If so, it might be a good time to have a change of heart!
