To be eligible for an EHV, an individual or family must meet one of four eligibility categories:

- 1. Homeless
- 2. At risk of homelessness
- 3. Fleeing, or attempting to flee, domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault. stalking or human trafficking.
- 4. Recently homeless and for whom providing rental assistance will prevent the family's homelessness or having high risk of housing instability.

Some can go as high as \$12,000 for inpatient treatment or as low as \$60 hourly for outpatient treatment. If your health insurance provider pays for mental health services, they may be able to cover some or all costs associated with your treatment.
