Filing Taxes 2021

It is that time of year...time to file your 2021 taxes. For those families that use the Preschool while you are at work or taking classes, our Tax Identification # is **86-6007618**. You can claim the cost of the Preschool on your income tax forms as a childcare expense.

Announcement: Did you know that it is time to start registering for Kindergarten at the local elementary schools? If you have a child that will be 5 years old by September 1, 2022, you will need to start making plans for where you would like to send your child. If your child does not meet the age requirement, please see me for more information about the Pre-K class.

Important Gate Procedures
