## **For Your Information:**

Many things have changed! Please be aware that our program is regulated by the AZ Dept of Health Services, Childcare Licensing. We are required to make health and safety changes that were not previously part of our program due to COVID19. Please help us make these requirements a smooth habit for everyone. ## Important: Signing In/Out

<u>Parents!</u> Remember, you will not be allowed into the classroom during the drop off time. You will be greeted by your teacher and the Director at the preschool gate. Please remember to sign in and out each day when you come with your child. We will ask a series of questions pertaining to their health every day during the drop off timeframe. Please be truthful and help us keep everyone safe. The child will continue to have their temperature taken. We appreciate your help! Thanks!

Dropping off your child: News for Everyone! Please know that we are taking every precaution to keep your child and your family safe. When coming on campus, please wear a mask from your car to the facility. We know that this is challenging but if we all work together it will help us to remain open and available for daily preschool for your child! Picking up your child: Please ring the doorbell and we will admit one parent at a time to come into the hallway to retrieve all belongings. Public Health requires the standards for social distancing to be in place at all times. We hope that there will be a time in the near future that will allow us to welcome you back into the classroom soon.

## Changes to Chapel

This school year looks a little different! So, chapel time for the first part of this year will be during the school day and will not have families joining us at this time. We will reassess the situation midyear and reevaluate if we will be able to welcome the families to join us then. #### Reminders to families

- Tuition is due on the first of every month. Please pay on time. If your balance is not paid by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month, you will incur a \$20 late fee per week until it is paid.
- Please call when you child is feeling sick and needs to stay home. This will help us stop the spread of germs to the other children and we are required by the State of AZ Public Health to document the reasons why they will be absent.

### **Daily Reminders**

Your child will need the following everyday this year:

- Backpack with an extra change of clothing inside marked with his name.
- 2. Sturdy pair of close-toed shoes worn to school.
- 3. Lunchbox with name written on it (if staying for Lunch Bunch).
