They are open five nights a week, Wednes-


day through Sunday. Round Up has a kitchen with a large variety of food available.

With 14 years of radio experience and over 20 years as a mobile entertainer, John has established himself as a versatile disc jockey and emcee for all events. He has also performed with and acted as emcee for several national recording acts including: Keith Anderson, Craig Morgan, The Wreckers, George Jones,



Vince Gill, Travis Tritt, Bree Sharp, and many others. John is also an accomplished dancer & choreographer having won competitions in New York, Las Vegas, Ft. Lauderdale, Massachusetts, and has danced at the UCWDC World Championships in 1998, 2000, and 2003.

John has also won technical praise as a consultant to some of the biggest entertainment companies in the country. Testimony to this could be found at

the Jam'n 94.5's "Jam Scam Boat Cruise", "In Style '97" events,

and several major dance festivals including the JG2 Line Dance Marathon, the Line Dance Showdown, Windy City Line Dance Mania, the Tampa Bay Line Dance Classic, the Boston Dance Revolution, and Worlds 2003, 2005, 2006 at Opryland in Nashville. He has also been



involved in the construction and/or renovation of many nightclubs and mobile sound companies.

Since 2004 John has been a DJ, Entertainment Director, and Operations Manager of the Round Up, South Florida's premier Country dance club.

Lisa Spangler, a line dance teacher, has been a household name since the late 1988. When Do-Da's needed to pump up the night, Lisa would come in and pump up the night. Dance Connection would fill the other nights and give everyone a chance to meet others. Line dancing has always been the draw that brought in all the people who weren't ready to partner dance. It's a great way to build your motor skills and coordination. Most of the line dancers eventually learn to partner dance and then meet someone, a companion that can dance. Lisa, eventually moved over to Pure Country, Gone Country and then Desperado's. Desperado's in 1998 produced a "Winning Line Dance Team" called the "Mustang's". They won 1st place at the UCWDC World's in Nashville.

When Desperado's closed their doors, Round Up wanted Lisa to pump it up and bring in the line dancers. During her time between her 14-year-old daughter and being the part-time dance coordinator for the Miami Heat when they need a special dance half-time show, Lisa still teaches privates and welcomes new dancers to Round Up.

American club in Hollywood has great attendance and rave reviews, especially from those less fortunate out-of-towners


who don't have the same thing back home.






